

# Long Lake Resorts the past 100 years

Listed resorts came from Fullers Tackle Shop. Maps 1928, 1937, 1946, and 1957 as displayed in Jerry Fuller's Pawn Shop entrance at 223 Main Street. Listed West Side, East Side, North to South and residences that replaced resorts. We also listed past owners of resorts.

Mr. Earl Fuller owned the "Fullers Tackle Shop" from 1912 to 1959. He sold a full line of hunting and fishing merchandise and rented outboard motors for \$1.50 per day. His son, Jerry, took over in 1959 to 1984 at which time it was sold to Pete Nyhus (1 yr) who sold to Reed's.

Shady Point	White color
